Lumen Christi students are adding a personal touch to Stations of the Cross this year. For many years the school has come together on Lenten Fridays to pray the Way of the Cross. This year several of our high school students have worked to bring about a more intimate encounter through this beautiful devotion. Each station is prayed in a separate room of the school; by grade students move along The Way as they move from room to room. While the traditional format is followed, each station is led by an upperclassman who engages students with tangible symbols that can be held. Students hear about and see such things as a student-created veil of Veronica, a crown of thorns from the Holy Land, a rendering of the Pieta, and dogwood flowers that students can take home as a reminder of Christ's Passion and Death. In addition, student leaders share interesting facts about the events of each station. Immediately following the procession, students reflect and journal on the experience. Special thanks to our Campus Minister, Mrs. Loeffler, for envisioning this new approach.

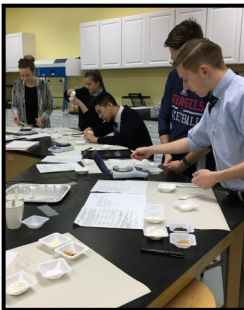

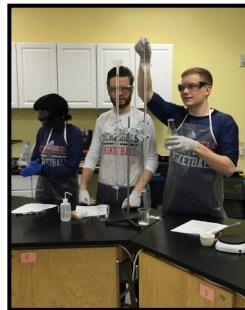

Working as members of a team, students use stoichiometry (a way of converting measurements) to make cookies. Yum!



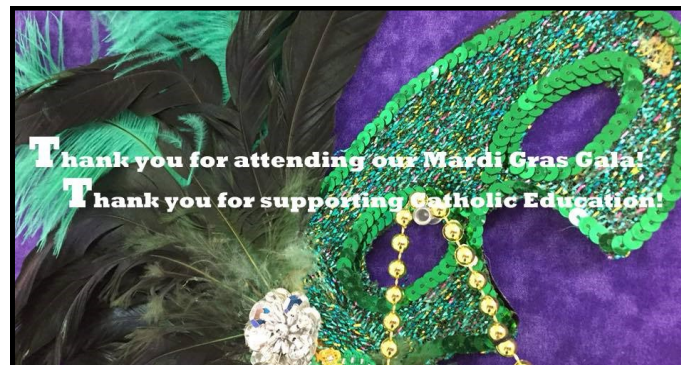
Nyadeng, Mark, and Trey team up to measure the calcium levels in egg shells under a variety of climatic conditions. Now, to the write-up!

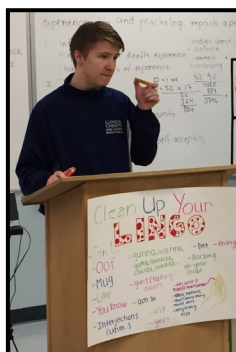

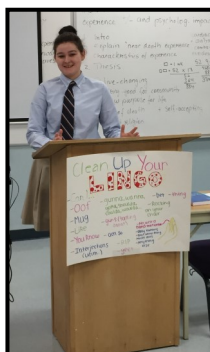
