## Regular Communication with Lumen Christi Stakeholders

September 4, 2018

Dear Members of the Lumen Christi High School Family,

In light of the revelations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy, the cover-up of these sins by Catholic bishops, and recent issues at Dimond High School, we believe you deserve a public statement from those to whom you entrust the Catholic education and daily welfare of your children.

**We are fully committed to the safety of every student at Lumen Christi Catholic High School. Assurance of that safety demands we promise you three things: accountability, transparency, and zero tolerance for sexual abuse.**

**Accountability:** Lumen Christi will continue to fully comply with the policies set forth by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' [Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People \("Promise to Protect, Pledge to Heal"\)](#) and the Archdiocese of Anchorage's [Code of Pastoral Conduct and Sexual Misconduct Policy](#). With the spirit of these documents in mind, while at Lumen Christi, all clergy, candidates for ordination, archdiocesan and parish employees, and volunteers working with minors or vulnerable adults will be required to:

1. Commit to the two-person rule, which says that no adult may ever be in a closed-door setting with a single minor. A third person must always be present, with the exception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the confessional.
2. Pass a thorough criminal background check before beginning ministry and every five years thereafter.
3. Complete safe environment training before beginning ministry and every two years thereafter.

**Transparency:** In the event of an abuse allegation, we will simultaneously pursue two goals: full, immediate reporting to the proper authorities, and protection of the affected student's privacy. In accordance with Alaska State law ([A.S. 47.17](#)), school teachers, administrative staff members, and athletic coaches of both public and private schools are mandated reporters. Additionally, all archdiocesan clergy, employees, and volunteers are ethically mandated to report any abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult directly to either the Anchorage Police Department or the Office of Child Protective Services (with whom the report may be filed anonymously). Once the police have completed their investigation, the Principal, in conjunction with the Archdiocese's Office of Safe Environment, may conduct an additional investigation. In consultation with law enforcement, all school and archdiocesan policies and procedures will be followed regarding notification of students and parents regarding harm, potential harm, and results of any additional investigation in a manner that ensures the safety of students and protects the privacy of victims.

**Zero Tolerance:** We personally promise you that we will remain vigilant in our common concern for the safety and well-being of every student entrusted into our care. Should you have

Dear Parents, Alumni, and Friends of Lumen Christi,  
On behalf of the staff and faculty of Lumen Christi High School, I am so very pleased to send you this Annual Report of our activities over the past year. As a ministry of Saint Benedict Parish, we continued to fulfill our mission of providing a rigorous Catholic education in a Christ-like environment to students in grades 7-12. In these pages, you will see our students and staff living out our Core Values of Faith, Family, and Excellence on a daily basis. Thanks to the commitment of time, talent, and treasure from so many in our community, you will also see how we sustained and improved Lumen's Catholic identity, maintained high standards of academic excellence and professionalism, and increased our marketing and development efforts in order to attract new families to your fine school.

**Faith:** Striving to strengthen our Catholic identity, particularly through growing in moral virtue, we commissioned beautiful hand-painted reproductions of Giotto Di Bondone's "Virtue Series" in our main hallway. Emphasizing the importance of fortitude and self-sacrifice, we took our Seniors on a first-ever offsite retreat focusing on "Servant Leadership." Our entire student body participated in Advent and Lent Reconciliation Services and several all-school novenas.

**Family:** Recognizing our baptismal call to serve others, our "family" is the greater community in which we live. Throughout the year, we supported faith in action/community service projects for hurricane victims in Texas, Clare House, Prestige Care, Bean's Cafe, H2O Water Project, Catholic Relief Services, and many others. We hosted several guest speakers, including a youth counselor, a representative from Catholic Relief Services, and the Director of the Vatican Observatory. We also organized student, parent, and faculty teams to participate in the Arthritis Foundation's "Jingle Bell Run" and the Special Olympics "Polar Plunge" in December. We even had over 30 students and a dozen parents walk in the 2018 Fur Rendezvous Grand Parade in February!

**Excellence:** For the first time in our school's history, we chartered a National Honor Society, with four initial members. We were awarded a grant from the Reetz Foundation here in Alaska which will be used in the 2018-2019 school year to support our campus ministry program, to purchase additional science materials, and to fund teacher and School Board professional development and advancement.

For a small school, we sure do have a lot going on! I hope you will enjoy reading about these activities and more in the following pages. You can take pride in our school, our students, our faculty and staff, and our entire community. I know I do! We look forward to celebrating Catholic education during Catholic Schools Week 2019 from January 27 to Feb 2, 2019. On Monday, January 28th, at 7:00pm, please join us for our 3rd Annual "State of the School" Address, where I will highlight accomplishments and details plans for the future. 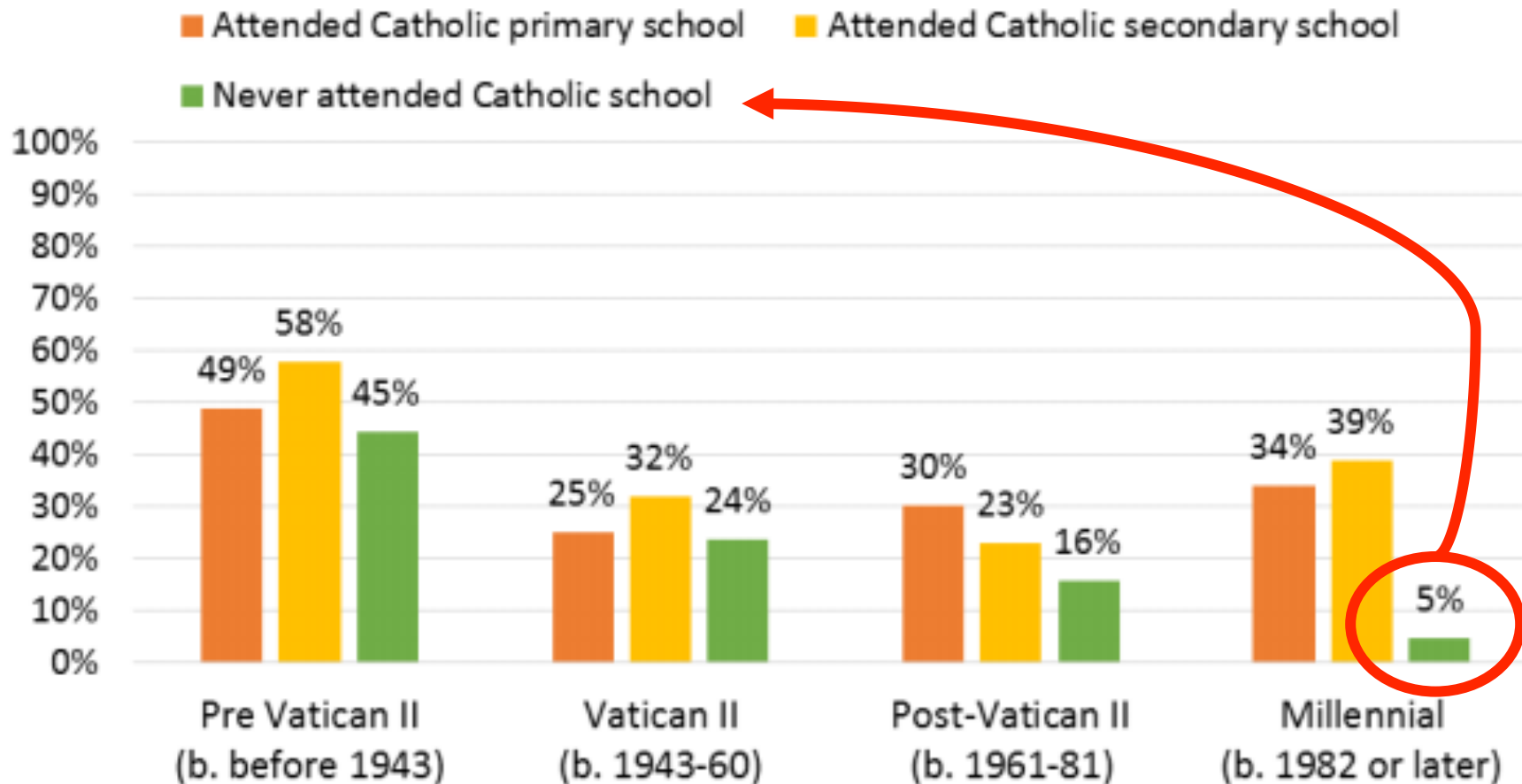

Percentage of Adult Catholics Attending Mass Weekly or More Often by Generation and Catholic School Attendance





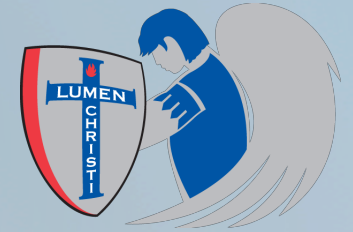

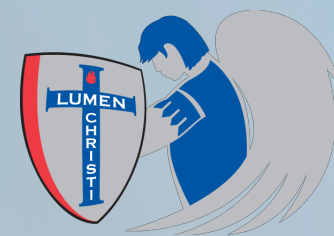
