



# Where Were You in the Great Hurricane of 2018?

#### What about emergencies?

One issue surrounding cell phone bans is contern about students having access to their phones in the event of a mass shooting. Anchorage experienced a hurricane last November, an event with the similar circumstances of widespread danger with no warning.

This was before the ban, and many kids "didn't have their phone on them anyway, they were in their lockers or in their backpack," when the building was evacuated. Students were able to use teachers' phones to notify their parents and landlines when they could return to the building. A message was also sent out via an app to notify parents that all students were safe.



### **Testing Program**



- English and Math Placement Tests for Admission
  - Determines English proficiency
  - Determines Math placement
- Standardized Tests Annually
  - Spring (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade): PSAT 8/9
  - Fall (9-11<sup>th</sup> Grade): PSAT NMSQT
  - 12th Grade: SAT/ACT (not required)
  - Spring (8<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade): ACRE (Assessment of Child/Youth Religious Education)







## Senior "Capstone" (2018 Objective)



- Interdisciplinary with Theology 12 and English Non-Fiction
- Focused on one or more of the 7 Principles of Catholic Social Teaching

Lower than Average Student Count The Past Three Years Has Meant Significant Additional Financial Pressure on the Parishioners of St. Benedicts and Substantial Indebtedness to the Archdiocese







  - -Offer Non-Fiction Course every fall vice every other year
