Principal's Update

Greetings from windy and blustery Healy, Alaska, where our high school soccer team is participating in the annual Tri-Valley Tournament through Saturday. Fall colors are in full bloom and there is a definite chill in the air. Please keep our Archangel players, drivers, chaperones, and parents in your prayers as our athletes take on teams from Su-Valley, Nenana, Delta Junction, Cook Inlet Academy, Birchwood, Holy Rosary Academy, and all points in between!

Our Servant Leadership retreat with our Class of 2023 and Class of 2024 was a smashing success! Based on the heartfelt reflections that I have reviewed so far, I believe our seniors and juniors are further encouraged to be servant leaders in our school throughout the school year.

We turn now towards Homecoming Week next week (see daily themes and schedule below) and the high school and junior high retreats on Sept 22-23. We will be sending retreat permission slips home early next week, so please review, sign, and return to the school. We are also looking for parent volunteers to serve as chaperones, assistant cooks, and other tasks, so this is a great way to earn your Share Hours! Here are the initial details for each retreat:

- High school: Students will come to school on Thursday, Sept 22nd at 7:30am as normal. High school students will then be bussed to St. Therese's camp where they will participate in retreat sessions, Mass, Adoration, Reconciliation, and other activities. <u>Students will stay overnight in the cabins</u>. On Friday, Sept 23rd, we will celebrate Mass, clean up the camp, complete closing activities, and return to school by bus for 1pm dismissal.
- Junior High: Students will come to school on Thursday, Sept 22nd at 7:30am as normal. Junior high students will remain at the school completing faith in action and team building activities, attending Mass, eating pizza lunch, and then walking down to Jewel Lake Bowl for afternoon fun. On Thursday, junior high students can be picked up at 2pm or ride the Lumen buses as normal. On Friday, Sept 23rd, junior high students will come to school at 7:30am and be transported out into the community to do faith in action activities. Following community service, students and chaperones will go to the Alaska Zoo, eat lunch, and return to the school for a 1pm dismissal (together with all high school students returning from St. Therese's).

Finally, all grandparents are invited to our school Mass next Friday, Sept 16th! Grandparents Day is on Sunday this weekend, so it's appropriate that we celebrate Mass in honor of our elders. We hope this will become another honored Lumen tradition.



School Board Fall Speaker Series Thursday, Oct 6th

Lumen Christi Catholic High School invites all parents and caring adults to our Fall 2022 School Board Speaker Series on Thursday, October 6, 2022 from 7-8:30pm in the Lumen gym. This event is free

and open to the public. Mr. Chris McKenna, a nationally recognized speaker from Protect Young Eyes, will be presenting "The Digital Culture of Kids: Building a Framework of Trust." After 7+ years, over 1,500 presentations, testifying in front of Congress, and countless conversations with parents, students, educators, and officers, Protect Young Eyes has discovered that parental controls alone don't work and instead, **there are 5 traits that often determine digital success in many families.** Chris calls these 5 traits the Digital Trust Framework. What is Digital Trust? Do you have it? How does it apply to conversations about social media? Pornography? YouTube? TikTok? This fast-paced talk will use stories, simple examples, and quick tips that will give your family immediate actions. 

First, the updates:

• The vigil web site is live and ready for sign ups! The vigil runs September 28 to November 6 from 7am to 7pm. You can look at the vigil details and sign up for hours at www.40daysforlife.com/en/anchorage. You will need to make an account to sign up for hours.

- Our opening prayer service is Saturday, October 1 at 330pm at St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church, 2901 E. Huffman Road. It is coming together! Two women who have had abortions, regretted them and journeyed toward healing with Project Rachel, are going to speak. We will pray, and we will sing! Let us praise God and beg His assistance together. Please mark October 1 at 330pm on your calendars opening prayer service.
- A local group has committed to filling our vigil on Tuesdays from 1 to 7pm, with four people in each hour. Wow!! Can you gather a group to fill a chunk of hours? Please pray about it and let me know.

And requests for help:

- Do you know of any business near Planned Parenthood that might allow us to park in their parking lot? Please let me know if so.
- Do you know of any business near Planned Parenthood that might allow us to store signs during hours that our vigil does not fill? (as well as overnight, 7pm to 7am, if possible) Golden Donuts has done this for us in the past, but unfortunately, they are not going to do that this year.
