Principal's Update


What a great week last week! From hosting Mr. Chris McKenna from Protect Young Eyes on Thursday, to kicking off the national Faith and Blue Weekend with an ice cream social with the Anchorage Police Department and the Alaska Police and Fire Chaplains on Friday, to seeing our girls volleyball team return from a successful trip to Unalaska, we were truly blessed with Faith, Family, and Excellence in our community.

This week, we look forward to some exciting girls volleyball action as over a dozen teams from around Alaska compete in our Lumen "Spiketacular" Tournament. Check below for the game schedule. We are encouraging our students to attend at least three games to earn a casual day, and we are incentivizing our student Houses to attend the Friday 6pm varsity game vs New Stuyahok. If 50% of a student House comes on Friday evening, the entire House earns a casual day! We could also use parent support in our concession stand, collecting gate entrance monies, and other areas (see Remind message and sign up below). So come on out to support our Lady Archangels and our school!!

Our Spanish classes are leading the school Rosary and Mass on Friday morning—this is an awesome way to start your work day. Drop off your son or daughter, come up to St. Benedict's church, and join us in prayer and the Sacrament of Holy Communion—you'll be back on the road by 8:40am!

Finally, please pray for our high school students as they take the PSAT on Saturday morning at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (gym). Arrive by 7:45am for an 8am start time. The PSAT is the only standardized testing we do here at Lumen and provides parents and students with data regarding performance in English Reading and Writing and Math. The PSAT also provides the school staff data on how to tailor our pedagogical approaches to ensure our students are meeting and exceeding national benchmarks. Junior high students will take the PSAT 8/9 in the spring semester.





- Our opening prayer service is Saturday, October 1 at 330pm at St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church, 2901 E. Huffman Road. It is coming together! Two women who have had abortions, regretted them and journeyed toward healing with Project Rachel, are going to speak. We will pray, and we will sing! Let us praise God and beg His assistance together. Please mark October 1 at 330pm on your calendars – opening prayer service.
- A local group has committed to filling our vigil on Tuesdays from 1 to 7pm, with four people in each hour. Wow!! Can you gather a group to fill a chunk of hours? Please pray about it and let me know.

And requests for help:

- Do you know of any business near Planned Parenthood that might allow us to park in their parking lot? Please let me know if so.
- Do you know of any business near Planned Parenthood that might allow us to store signs during hours that our vigil does not fill? (as well as overnight, 7pm to 7am, if possible) Golden Donuts has done this for us in the past, but unfortunately, they are not going to do that this year.
- I need help contacting area churches to share the vigil with as many people as possible; planning the prayer service (worship handout, gear table, decorations); speaking at area churches; putting signs together; and more. Contact me if you can help!

Please pray for God's grace to pour out us as we prepare for our vigil. Let's beg Him to open the hearts of all who live here to end abortion in our city.
