Many thanks to all those in our community who are coming out to hear Mr. Chris McKenna speak about the digital culture of our kids tonight! It promises to be a great and informative presentation!

It gives me great pleasure to welcome Mr. Doug Berry as our new Campus Minister! Mr. Berry, and his wife Rebecca, were parishioners at St. Benedict's for over 20 years before a short respite in Idaho to finish up a successful career with UPS.

Doug and Rebecca have returned home to Alaska to stay and we look forward to having him minister to our students, staff, and families. Doug graduated from Kodiak High School and served for four years in the US Army. During his 30 year career with UPS, he rose from driver to Package Division Manager of Idaho and Wyoming supervising over 1400 employees. Doug has extensive experience in faith formation and youth and adult ministry, including presenting at the annual Alaska Catholic Youth Conference (ACYC), serving as small group leader for St. Benedict's high school Youth Program for over a decade, and co-hosting St. Benedict's "Super Sunday" events. In addition to his active presence in parish life, Doug completed 1.5 years in the Archdiocese Diaconate Studies program before his move to Idaho interrupted continued progress towards becoming a Deacon. Doug and Rebecca have two children and two grandchildren. Joshua Berry graduated from Lumen Christi in 2006, and married Shannon (nee Craig), Lumen Christi Class of 2005, so the Berry's are a full-fledged Lumen Alumni family! In addition to his duties as our Campus Minister, Doug will also serve as St. Benedict's junior high youth minister, which will be a mutually beneficial win-win for both the school and the parish!







GALA: We need Glass Bottles



- Our opening prayer service is Saturday, October 1 at 330pm at St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church, 2901 E. Huffman Road. It is coming together! Two women who have had abortions, regretted them and journeyed toward healing with Project Rachel, are going to speak. We will pray, and we will sing! Let us praise God and beg His assistance together. Please mark October 1 at 330pm on your calendars opening prayer service.
- A local group has committed to filling our vigil on Tuesdays from 1 to 7pm, with four people in each hour. Wow!! Can you gather a group to fill a chunk of hours? Please pray about it and let me know.

- Do you know of any business near Planned Parenthood that might allow us to park in their parking lot? Please let me know if so.
