## Principal's Update

I encourage you to read all of Lumen News and take notice of the amazing final numbers earned at the Gala, the news from our National Honor Society, the need for parent assistance at the Regions Basketball Tournament next week, and the great success of the Winter Retreat last weekend! We hope that this information will continue to keep you well informed of all the great things happening here at Lumen!

In other news, our illustrious School Board has wrapped up its inquiry and fact-finding session about the public correspondence school allotment program and is working on interim guidance for current and prospective parents for we intend to proceed.

On Wednesday, our students attended Ash Wednesday Mass and started our 40 day journey of Lent. We are encouraging our students to pray, give alms, and fast during this time and, as a school, we will complete some time honored Lenten traditions including:

- Every Monday (see schedule above), we will hold Stations of the Cross here in the school building at 1pm. Parents are invited to walk with our students through this simple, yet moving, devotional prayer activity in which our upperclass lead their Houses through the 14 stations of the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ, from His condemnation by Pilate to His death and His entombment. Just meet at the gym at 1pm every Monday starting Feb 27th! We will complete the Stations of the Cross on Holy Thursday, April 6, at 1pm as our final school activity before dismissing for the Triduum and Easter Sunday and Monday.
- On Fridays during Lent, our staff members volunteer to make meatless soups and other dishes for lunch for purchase by staff and students for \$2 per bowl. Proceeds from these Lenten soup lunches will go to a charitable organization of the staff's choosing. Please consider sending cash with your son or daughter on Fridays and encourage them to support this long time Lumen tradition.
- Our Student Leadership Board (SLB) is organizing another school wide canned food drive, this time
  to support the Knights of Columbus "40 Cans for Lent" drive throughout Alaska. The House which
  brings in the most number of cans (average per student) will earn a casual week after Lent. Cans
  (no Ramen, please) are due on Tuesday, April 4, during Holy Week. Make a small sacrifice and turn
  it into a big difference in the lives of others.
- Additionally, Mr Berry has challenged the students in Houses to save their extra change and support
  Operation Rice Bowl (<a href="https://www.crsricebowl.org/">https://www.crsricebowl.org/</a>) for Catholic Relief Services. The House that
  collects the most amount of change and cash will earn a casual day after Lent. Donations for the
  Rice Bowl provide lifesaving support to nearly 200 million people in over 100 countries.
- Each year, many of our students and families participate in the Good Friday Faith Walk, from St. Benedict's to downtown Anchorage. There is no school that day and the Faith Walk is a great opportunity for families to earn both Share Hours and Faith in Action hours, while walking the Way of the Cross. More details to follow but save the date for Friday, April 7.
- Finally, most of the teachers in our school have challenged our students to fast or abstain from certain things over the course of our Lenten journey, from not allowing sweets and snacks in Mrs. Spillers' classes to the Lenten Language Clean-Up in Dr. Carlson's room. We encourage you to organize your own challenges at home during this Lenten penitential season!

Good luck to our boys and girls basketball teams as they head to games against Cook Inlet Academy in Soldotna on Friday, to our junior high volleyball team as they compete in jamborees on Friday and Saturday, and to the members of our Debate team as they compete in the ASAA/First National Bank DDF State Championships at Bettye Davis East High School Friday, Saturday, and Sunday as well!

# **Campus Minister Thoughts**



Magic? Dance? Sing? Poetry? Rubik's Cubes? Pogo stick? Unicycle? Dad Jokes?


Please COME SHARE it with us on the stage in the Lumen Gym at 7pm.
