## Principal's Update

Congratulations to our Lumen junior high volleyball teams for winning both the Gold and Silver divisions of last weekend's jamboree! This week, Lumen hosts the Peninsula Conference Regions Basketball Tournament. Two teams for both boys and girls will earn berths to the State championships. Our teams have been working hard this season, so let's fill our bleachers with spirited Lumen families! Many thanks also to those who have volunteered to man the gate table, sell concessions, and host the hospitality room. Our Student Leadership Board has challenged the student body to attend at least two games and earn a casual day at school next week! So come on out and cheer on our Archangel teams!

On a more serious note, I encourage you to talk with your son or daughter about the rapid rise and popularity of Artificial Intelligence (AI) programs like ChatGPT among our youth in just the past couple of months. What is AI and how is it impacting our educational system? You can do a quick web search on the topic, but I found this article (among many others) helpful:

While AI, like many forms of technology, is useful and can often support our efforts in the classroom and educational/work setting, unfortunately, we have recently seen an increase in its use by some students on assignments, tests, homework and papers. In essence, autogenerating entire essays (or large portions thereof) or autogenerating answers to question prompts on assignments (two recent examples) is intellectually lazy as well as dishonest. While we are working to clarify the language for this new phenomena in our Academic Honesty policy (found on page 18 in our Parent Student Handbook here: <a href="https://lumenchristiak.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/11/LCHS-Parent-Student-Handbook-2022-23.pdf">https://lumenchristiak.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/11/LCHS-Parent-Student-Handbook-2022-23.pdf</a>), please know that our entire faculty view these incidents as violations of academic integrity and we are handling them accordingly.

Over the past week, we have addressed this new form of academic dishonesty with our students, and we will continue to do so. As we partner together to help raise our students with virtue, integrity, and honor in all that they do, I encourage you to discuss this topic with your son or daughter and help us reinforce the following:

- Honesty in academic work is a fundamental requirement in our Catholic school setting (indeed, in any setting) where living a life of integrity and virtue is paramount.
- Just as there are AI programs to autogenerate answers to school assignments, there are also programs to determine with a high degree of accuracy whether a student's work is AI generated.
- Further, one of the many beautiful things about the small class sizes at Lumen Christi is that our students are known here. In this case, we know when a student's writing or work is atypical from what that student usually completes (better or worse). This is normally an indicator that something has changed and our teachers make an effort to "connect the dots" with our students. Unfortunately, in recent days in some cases, this has meant that a few students have used AI to do their work for them.
- Finally, Lumen Christi prides itself on developing graduates who communicate effectively, think critically, and solve problems. While technology can assist us with these skills, we must still rely upon the greatest supercomputer the world has ever known—the human brain.


#### **Announcements from NHS:**

## Extreme Retreat 4X4X48

March 24th 7:30 pm until March 26th 6:00 pm
We will gather in the upper room in the gym for a PROMPT 8pm Start.
You will then *choose* one of two paths. Every 4 hours you complete 4 miles (Run / Walk) or do 4 Rosaries in the prayer corner in the upper room. At the next 4 hour mark (12:00am) we will do that again.

This is an <u>EITHER / OR</u> retreat, <u>NOT flip flop between</u>. It is an EXTREME event that will test your ability to fight through lack of sleep. During *your limited down time*, we will remain in the upper room in community (Unless you are a Seminarian who has other duties). You can use *your limited down time* to rest, nap, play games.....

The showers in the locker rooms will be available during your limited down time.

You will be providing your own nutrition during the event, so bring what you will need to consume on *your limited down time*.

This is <u>NOT a chaperoned event</u>, so if your child is participating, then you must participate with them. The adults participating will need to focus on themselves to see it through.

Due to the extreme nature, not ALL will finish. It is usually at 40% completion rate.

Those who do see it through will have a pizza fest at 5:30pm on Friday March 26th, also in the upper room.
