








### Math Curriculum Review




- Spring 2022: Reviewed standards, textbooks, and learning outcomes and interviewed students, teachers, and alumni
  - Summary of Findings:
    - Alumni reported they were "well prepared for post-high school careers"
    - Alumni and current students appreciated individual attention received at Lumen
    - Our students score an average of 48 points higher on SAT math than national average
    - Small revisions to General Math and Pre-Algebra curriculums






#### **House System**




- Further connects all classes within the school (grades 7-12 vertically connected in a single House = 18-20 students per House)

(At any time during the retreat you can bow out, as it is an EXTREME event that not all will finish)










## Language Arts and Science Curriculum Reviews
