







 - "Create opportunities for Lumen Christi parents to directly engage with one another, both in faith formation and socially"


















- Judy Friar (ASD counselor for 20+ years) meets with our students 2-3 times per month
 - 9th grade: Importance and impact of grades.
 Understanding a transcript. Encourage participation in school (clubs, activities, etc.)
 - 10th grade: Career Interest Inventory. Discuss career choices and post high school education
 - 11th grade: Exploring colleges and finding the perfect fit.
 - 12th grade: Finalizing the college essay, which can be a resume builder. Prep for Early Admissions Nov. 1.





Enrollment Update



Increased enrollment has helped reduce financial "burden" on St. Benedict's from high of \$199k/yr in 2017 to \$0 in 2023 and 2024!!
